

WE DON'T KNOW IF LABS ARE COVERED BY YOUR INSURANCE COMPANY

Sorry, we just don't know and we are unable to call them to find out. We can draw the labs, but if they turn out not to be covered, you will be responsible for payment, either to the lab or to our office.

Sometimes the lab will tell you: "if the doctor re-codes the visit, your lab will be paid for". This is not necessarily true. Remember, if we change the diagnosis, this is part of the medical record. So we would not want to make something up.

I know this is complicated, after nearly 20 years of practice, I still can't figure it out.

I have read the above notification and I understand that I am responsible for knowing what my insurance company does and does not cover and I am ultimately responsible for the labs that the insurance company does not pay for.
